METAVERSE, BETWEEN ECOLOGY OF VIRTUAL AND PHENOMENOLOGY OF EXPERIENCE Pio Alfredo Di Tore, Eva Podovšovnik Axelsson

On 11/25/2022 the University of Cassino and Lazio Meridionale hosted the third edition of the conference "Ubiquity, Presence, Distance". The 2022 edition was dedicated to the theme "Metawelt: Bodies, Interactions, Educations". The event, in its third edition, took place in a particular historical moment: on the one hand, we are downstream of the greatest experimentation of the use of digital technologies in educational contexts, forced experimentation due to the exceptional moment of the pandemic and characterized by the use of technologies that have reached a degree of full maturity; on the other, we are beginning to glimpse the potential, in the educational field, of the new generations of digital environments and tools (Metaverse, Artificial Intelligence, Internet of Things). Recent experience underlines the urgency of opening a reflection, in the pedagogical field, on the nature of the tools that will soon revolutionize the web, understood here as a privileged place for the construction of social reality.
